

## 14. The Gallery

### 14.1 Introduction

The Gallery is a temporary workspace where you can simultaneously browse through and view various image clips using a “synopsis” of flipbooks. Clips can be arranged freely or restricted to lines and columns, almost like characters and words in a text editor. In the Gallery working area, you can...

- Insert clips
- Delete clips
- Change the order of clips
- Preview clips in a sequence
- Save the complete setup, and
- Import and export clips to/from other Jaleo applications.

The Gallery is intended to facilitate visualization of project content and preselection of clips in a highly visual manner.

### 14.2 Starting the Gallery

The Gallery can be started:

- From the ToolChest
- By double clicking on its desktop icon
- By dropping a clip file on its desktop icon
- By typing `Gallery` from any shell

## 14.3 Application Window

The Gallery Window consists of a menu bar and a work area in which clips can be placed. A grid can optionally be activated to align loaded clips in an orderly manner.

## 14.4 Gallery Functions

### 14.4.1 Import clips

Use drag&drop to load clips from the desktop or other Jaleo applications into the Gallery. Alternatively, you can use the loader or the menu commands of the Gallery.

### 14.4.2 Export Clips

You can export a list of previously selected clips by dragging from the Gallery’s background to any other Jaleo application.

### 14.4.3 Selecting Clips

- Click on the name

Whenever you select a clip, the title will be displayed in white and a number will appear on the upper right hand side of the window indicating its position within the selection list. As clicking on a clip name without any further measures will deselect all clips previously selected, this number will be 1.

- Press shift and click on the name

This will select the clip without deselecting clips previously selected. The selection number will be the previously highest selection number incremented by one. Clicking on a previously selected clip will deselect the clip, forcing all other selection numbers to be updated.

- Click on the Gallery background and drag a box with the mouse

All of the clips within the box will be selected.

- Click on any other area of the windows background in order to deselect all clips.

Clip names use the following color code:

- Black: not selected
- White: selected. A “selection order number” will be displayed to the right of the clip name. The selection order is only used for preview of clips in a sequence, as this will proceed in order of selection.
- Red: The clip is currently played back

### 14.4.4 Move Clips

In order to move one or more clips within the Gallery:

- Select all of the clips that you wish to move
- Press and hold the mouse button over the name of any clip within the selection
- Drag the clips to the desired position
- Let the mouse button go.

### 14.4.5 Erase Clips

In order to delete one or more clips within the Gallery:

- Select all of the clips that you wish to delete
- Press the DEL button (delete)

### 14.4.6 Move the Galleries' Background

In order to move the Galleries display window background to show clips outside of the view area, you can:

- Use the scroll bars.
- Use one of the following keys:
  - End (end of page): Positions the view area to the last clips in the Gallery
  - Home (beginning of page): Positions the view area to the upper left corner
  - Start: Moves the background to the left hand side
  - End: Moves the background to the right hand side

## **14.5 Gallery Menu**

### **14.5.1 File Menu**

#### **File > New**

Clears all Gallery content

#### **File > Open**

Loads a previously stored Gallery setup, using a simple standard file selector box.

#### **File > Load**

Opens the Loader window. This allows you to select Gallery files and any other type of Gallery compatible clips.

#### **File - Load Project**

Allows you to automatically load all suitable image clips of the current project into the Gallery with a single menu command.

#### **File > Save**

Saves the current Gallery setup in a Gallery file.

#### **File > Save As**

Saves the current Gallery setup under a different name

#### **File > Exit**

Closes the Gallery.

### **14.5.2 Edit**

#### **Edit > Cut**

Copies the active selection to the clipboard and deletes it afterwards from the Gallery. From the clipboard, it can later be pasted into the Gallery using the paste command.

#### **Edit > Copy**

Copies the active selection to the clipboard (to be pasted later using the paste command.)

**Edit > Paste**

Pastes the clipboard content into the Gallery. If nothing is selected in the Gallery, the contents of the Clipboard will be inserted in the upper left corner of the Gallery. If one or more clips have been selected, the contents of the Clipboard will be inserted behind the last clip of the selection.

**Edit > Delete**

Deletes the selected clips from the Gallery: Select the clip or clips that you wish to delete from the Gallery Press the Delete button.

**Edit > Delete All**

Deletes all the clips present in the Gallery.

**Edit > Select All**

Selects all clips present in the Gallery. The selected clips are numbered according to the sequence of selection. If you use shuttle playback commands, clips will be played back in the order of selection.

**Edit > Split Line**

Splits a line within the Gallery. A line break is inserted after the last selected clip, in effect breaking a long line of clips into two lines.

**Edit > Move Up**

Affects the selected clip and all of those that follow until the end of the Gallery, and moves them up one line. (If the previous line is not empty, these clips will hide the existing clips.)

**Edit > Move Down**

Affects the selected clip and all of those that follow until the end of the Gallery and moves them down one line. (If the following line is not empty, these clips will hide the existing clips.)

**14.5.3 Shuttle**

Controls the playback of selected clips in the Gallery window. If multiple clips are selected, they will be played back in selection order.

**Shuttle > Stop**

Stops sequence playback.

**Shuttle > Pause**

Momentarily pauses the sequence playback. Press “Pause” again to continue playback.

**Shuttle > Play Forward**

Normal forward playback. If multiple clips are selected, at the end of one clip playback will proceed with the next clip in selection order (as indicated by the selection numbers in the upper right corner of the clip display)

**Shuttle > Play Backwards**

Reverse playback. If multiple clips are selected, at the end of one clip playback will proceed with the previous clip in reverse selection order (as indicated by the selection numbers in the upper right corner of the clip display)

**Shuttle > Fast Forward**

Fast forward playback.

**Shuttle > Fast Rewind**

Fast reverse playback.

**Shuttle > Goto Begin**

Goes to the first frame of the first clip of the selection.

**Shuttle > Goto End**

Goes to the last frame of the last clip of the selection.

**14.5.4 Set Up****Set Up > Show Grid**

Displays a grid on the Gallery's background

**Set Up > Snap Grid**

Forces each clip to a position constrained by the grid, be it visible or not.
